SUBJECT : PANAMA CANAL ADJUSTMENT FACTOR

To All Valued Customers:

The Panama Canal is facing one of the most severe droughts it has experienced in half a century, which has caused an increase in the Canal tariff as the booking windows for transiting the Neo-Panamax locks will be reduced by 30% as of January 1, 2024.

Therefore, please be advised that JAS Forwarding as agent for Blue World Line will implement a Panama Canal Adjustment Factor for shipments from U.S.A. Ports that are crossing the Panama Canal effective January 1, 2024
