CHANGES FROM CHIEF TO CUSTOMS DECLARATION SERVICE (CDS)

CUSTOMS DECLARATION

WHAT IS CHANGING

HMRC will be closing the Customs Handling of Import and Export Freight (CHIEF) System
The Customs Declaration Service (CDS) will be the single customs platform for which services will be withdrawn in two stages:

- 1) 30th September 2022 Import declarations close on CHIEF
- 2) 31st March 2023 Export declarations close on CHIEF and the National Exports System (NES)

HOW TO PREPARE

Register for CDS (Customs Declaration Service) via the Government Gateway

Authorise JAS Forwarding (UK) Limited EORI GB417234569000 via your Government Gateway account under the deferment option.





For Clients operating their own Deferment account we ask that you provide JAS Forwarding (UK) Limited with your CCG reference # so we may update our records immediately.

CHOOSE WHICH PAYMENT METHOD TO USE

Clients with a Deferment Account

CDS uses a separate HMRC bank Account to CHIEF. You are required to set up additional direct debits with HMRC for use with CDS.

DO NOT CANCEL YOUR CHIEF D/D

Clients without a Deferment Account

The Flexible Accounting System (FAS) is replaced with the NEW CASH ACCOUNTS for CDS declarations. Once registered for CDS you will be

automatically issued with a cash account. Pay funds into your own cash account and authorise JAS Forwarding (UK) Limited to use the account

on your behalf (or use the option of Immediate payments)
